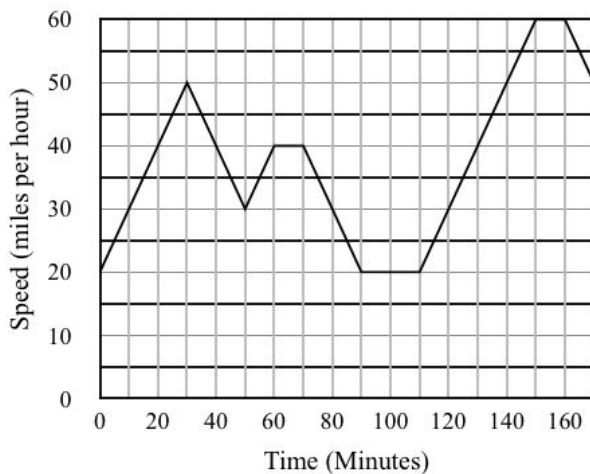
The equation above represents a parabola in the xy -plane. Which of the following equivalent forms of the equation displays the x -intercepts of the parabola as constants or coefficients?
